AT&T Cabling security policy is aimed to provide optimal security to our employees, information, property and assets, minimizing exposure to both internal and external threats.

All actions taken under this security policy should be done within the guidelines of AT&T Cabling Systems Environment, Health & Safety Policy and AT&T Cabling Systems Code of Ethics.

Secure operations are dependent upon employee participation, commitment and accountability.

All security procedures and guidelines should be seamlessly integrated into the normal business activities.

The following points provide the basic security policy guidelines:

1. The security and protection of our employees is the first priority of all business activity.
2. All security issues, procedures and guidelines should not violate any human right, any international and national laws, and should always preserve human dignity.
3. AT&T Cabling management is fully responsible for all security aspects of its business activities and it must allocate all the resources needed to pursue this responsibility.
4. AT&T Cabling security officer must perform continuous threats and risks analysis, focusing on prevention as a first priority.
5. In order to tackle all security incidents quickly and effectively proper response plans shall be prepared for several major risk scenarios. All response plans shall be tested and proven to be effective.
6. All security incidents, including security breaches and irregularities, must be reported and recorded. Corrective action should be taken in case of need.
